



✓ Before moving the machine, the service tank's water must be empty and the boiler must be fully cooled down.




- Do not place liquids such as water or milk on the cup warmer, and keep falling objects away from the machine.
- ✓ Do not use a piece of cloth to cover the machine.
- Keep out of children's reach and make sure children do not use the machine.






 using too many plugs at once can lead to a power overload fire



- ✓ Keep the machine away from heat sources or other electronics.
- The risk of electrocution exists when touching the machine with wet hands.



- ✓ Close the steam and hot water valve clockwise until completely closed before using.
 ※ At first usage, keep the hot water knob open half turn
 - ** At first usage, keep the not water knob open nair turn counterclockwise. (This is to remove water from the hot water boiler.)
- Steam and hot water valves are burn hazards immediately after use when touched. Please use the rubber handle to hold.



Group head is extremely hot when on.

Please avoid burn damage by not touching the group head.

How to use

*For Zarre, you can check the status of the machine by checking the color of power and extraction light blinking.



No water in service tank

√ The power switch's red lamp blinks rapidly.



When refilling the service tank, make sure the service tank is removed from the machine.



Steam pump water level is coming up to spec

The power switch's red lamp blinks at a medium speed.



Hot water supply pump is operating

The power switch's red lamp binks at a slow speed



The extraction switch's green lamp will blink until the hot water boiler is up to extraction-ready temperature

The machine is ready to extract when the extraction switch's green lamp stops blinking.



When the steam boiler gauge pressure is at 1.5 bar before extraction



How to use

1. How to plumb-out drainage (optional)



1) Separate the drip tray rubber seal.




2) Connect the drain tube (1.4m) to the bottom structure of the drip tray



Unless you are using automated draining, this installation is not necessary

this installation is not necessary.

How to use

Recommended single extraction time is maximum 60 seconds, and we recommend 2 minute rest time after every use.


※ 30 second extraction / 1 minute rest (based on 2 shot lungo, 80ml extraction)

1. water tank removal and cleaning

Before connecting to power, remove water tank in order of the diagrams below and fill water tank with water.




1) Open the external water tank cover and remove the water tank by pulling upwards.



2) Clean water tank and remove outer moisture.







- 4) Place the water tank in the machine by grabbing the water tank with both hands.
- 5) Attach outer water tank case.

2. Connecting the machine power




- 1) After checking precautions, connect machine side plug and connect power plug to the power supply.
- 2) Switch main power switch to the on position.



- Please read precautions and connect.
- Before turning the machine on, make sure the steam / hot water knobs are turned all the way clockwise in a locked position.

3. Turning on machine and preheating




- 1) Power turns on when the power botton on the front left side of the machine is pushed.
- 2) When turning the machine on for the first time, the pump will operate and the boiler will get filled up with water from the water tank.
- 3)When the right extraction button stops blinking and the steam boiler's pressure gauge reads 1.5 bar, all preheating steps are completed.



Because the boiler requires a lot of water to get to normal operating conditions, please fill water up to the guide line in the service tank.

How to use

4 extraction



 Dose an adequate amount of coffee into the portafilter basket, and tamp using a tamper.




When tamping, make sure the portafilter is in a secure position and avoid wrist injuries by not applying excessive pressure.



2) Lock in the portafilter from the 7 o'clock position to 6 o'clock position

A. When locking the portafilter in, ensure it is level. Both wings of the portafilter must be fully inside the group head before locking in.

b. Before locking the portafilter in, we recommend a 1-2 second flushing of the group by turning the brew group lever up.





When locking in the portafilter, pay extra attention to the group head as it is a burn hazard

*brew water and group head temperature ranges from 85-99°C which are high temperatures

 Begin extraction by pushing the extraction switch until desired amount is reached.





Do not use hot water valve during extraction.


- Overly forced portafilter lock-in and removing the portafilter mid-extraction can cause damages to the machine and can cause bodily injuries from high temperature and high pressure.
- Remove portafilter after extraction is finished by turning the portafilter handle from 6 o'clock to 7 o'clock position.
- Remove coffee puck from portafilter, wash portafilter, then wipe with dry cloth.

How to use

5. Using steam



- Place steam wand inside of a steam pitcher with milk inside, turn steam knob counter clockwise, begin steaming milk.
- 2) When milk reaches appropriate temperature, turn steam knob clockwise to completely locked position.





- 1. When steam wand makes direct contact with skin, it can become a
- 2. Please operate by holding the rubber handle of the steam wand.
- 3. When releasing condensate, please turn nozzle over to the drip tray and use wet towel to cover nozzle before releasing.
- 4. Directly touching steam that's being released is a burn hazard

6. Using hot water





- 1) When hot water tap is turned half counterclockwise, hot water comes out.
- 2) When desired amount of hot water is reached, turn the hot water knob clockwise to lock.



When the hot water wand comes in direct contact with skin, it is a burn hazard.


Please operate by holding the hot water wand's rubber handle.

* Once finished using, push the machine power button to switch the machine off to avoid any secondary damages or burns while cleaning.

7. How to install and remove shower screen


1. Place the shower screen and gasket on top of the portafilter without the basket.



2. Take the prepared portafilter with shower screen and gasket, place into the group head and turn as far counterclockwise as the portafilter can go to install shower screen.










If the gasket does not go in well, use a blunt tool to push it upward.



- 3. Check for correct installation by placing a basket inside the portafilter and attaching the portafilter to the group head.
 - When using a new gasket, the portafilter may not turn to its original fully locked position of 6'O clock."









1. Cleaning the group head



- Remove the shower screen from group head as shown in the diagramUse
 - ** use tool to remove the shower screen and be careful to not scratch or damage the group head.
- 2) Clean with a cleaning brush




3) After cleaning, use the portafilter to re-install the shower screen







4. cleaning drip tray



- Take both hands to grip the ends of drip tray then slowly pull the drip tray forwards away from machine.
- 2) Keep pulling the drip tray slowly until the sticking point, lift gently and fully remove
- 3) After removing and cleaning, install the opposite order of removal.



5. Side panel removal



 Using the included removal tool, remove the side panel bolt.

2) After removing every bolt, remove the side panel from the machine main body.

Q & A

Q. Steam comes out of the drip tray after the machine is first turned on.

A.This is a normal procedure of the vacuum breaker functioning and filling pressure inside the steam boiler.

Q.Power switch button keeps blinking.

A.Fill water in water tank. or Machine is still preheating to desired temperature.

Q.When first plugged in, the machine makes noise.

A.The noise is from the pump working to fill the boiler with water. Please check to see if there is water in the water tank.

Q.Pressure while extracting is not stable or pressure is different than usual.

A.Adjust grind size or use fresh coffee.

Q. Water leaks out of the portafilter during extraction.

A.There may be too much coffee or the portafilter may not be fully attached to the group head. Please tamp after dosing coffee up to the basket line and attach portafilter into grouphead fully until the portafilter can no longer move.




Every heating element is composed of over 3 different safety mechanisms and tools. Use without worry!

Some consumable parts must be replaced regularly throughout use. (consumable parts: gasket, screen, basket, block spring, hot water and steam nozzle rubberring)




1. Twist the controller connection cap located at the rear of the machine.

X Please turn the main power switch position to "OFF" before plugging in.





WARNING

Plug in after matching up the notches. Communication cord must not be extended or tampered with. Damages may occur when using the controller on top of the machine or in high temperature environments.

3. Once plugged into the machine, turn the securing lock nut to fix the position and turn the power on by turning the main power switch located at the bottom right position to "ON"





Precautions

- Keep sharp / flammable/combustible objects safe and away.
- Do not place heavy objects on top of the controller.
- Do not forcefully twist or apply force to the controller dial part.
- Do not keep the controller on top of the machine.
 Use on a flat surface.
- When not using the controller, switch the main power switch to "OFF" and then disconnect the cable.
